Education, Health, Development and Village – Town Co-operation are the four pillars based on which all the villagers in the cluster are brought together for nation worship. The Trust has been successful in expanding the horizons of education in the entire area, thereby inculcating character, discipline and brotherhood among the next generation of citizens of Bharat.

The well heard of hostel for the needy boys has become the talk of the region. The Trust has started a free vehicle service for girls to enable their travel to school and back, thus making it easier for them to get educated. Along with these facilities, the Trust undertakes various other activities like Village Health Camps, Veterinary Health Camps, Women Small Saving Groups, Vocational Training Camps which facilitate the overall development in these rural areas. The trust takes up all these responsibilities without any aid from the Government. The trust works relentlessly as a link between villagers and the town, which help in resolving many developments in the rural area.

Torana Boys Hostel

Since 1986, Trust has been running a hostel for the needy and promising male students. The boys from such villages in Bhor-Velha area, where schools have not yet reached are given a priority for admissions. Yet there are a few students from other Talukas and villages in Pune District.

Boys from all religions, castes and creed are given admissions. The hostel runs its day-to-day routine in a disciplined manner. Festivals, functions and specials days are celebrated with enthusiasminthe Hostel.

The trust works towards imbibing patriotism, and creating ideal citizens of Bharat by ensuring their educational development.

Rural Development







Rural development is the need of an hour in this area where water scarcity is a norm in spite of heavy rainfall. With this motive in mind the Trust actively participates in conducting Village meets and Sarpanch Meets to discuss the problems of the villagers and their plausible solutions.

These attempts of the Trust have led to construction of wells, weirs, increasing the depth of farm ponds, levelling the hills to enable farming on such lands etc. The Trust undertakes a survey and prioritizes such villages which need a dire support. Some of the major projects include Ghisar, Gruhini, Khulshi, Nigde, Kumble, Waghmachi, Metpilavare, Chandavane, Damguda Asni, Wadgaon Zanze, & Pabe, where construction of wells is undertaken. The water scarcity in these villages is now contained.

Many villages are still deprived of basic infrastructure facilities like good quality roads and electricity. The Trust has been successful in following up with the Government Authorities and a few villages are now reaping the benefits of these follow ups.

School Van for Girl Students

Since last many years the Trust is working towards encouraging girl education in the rural areas of Velha & Bhor.

A Solution was framed to overcome the difficulties faced by girl students to travel long distances to school and back home. The Trust provided a free school bus service for these girls. Initially a minibus was provided by the Trust.

Later, cognizance was taken of this program and through the virtue of CSR, two big buses were donated to the Trust. Out of these two, one bus is used for school going girls and one is used for college going girls. Due to this second bus, the dream to take further education is now a reality for many girls.

Women Empowerment through Self Employment

Due to scarcity of water in this region, double cropping is not possible. As a result, the men in the house need to go to urban areas in search of labour work for the remaining year. The Trust provides a few vocational trainings to the women in these villages to enable them to earn for themselves from their homes.

Poultry Farming, stitching traditional blankets & bags, conkerberry pickle, hand pounded rice are the areas where the Trust provides training for the women.

Under the project of poultry farming, 10 women farmers are selected who get 25 birds each. A Volunteer is appointed to mentor and help these poultry farmers. As a result, these women farmers are able to earn a livelihood for themselves without leaving the responsibility of their homes.













BMCC Satellite Centre

The efforts taken by the Trust for the education of the students have now bear sweet fruits.

Brihan Maharashtra College of Commerce has started an educational satellite center at the Torna Rajgad Parisar Samajonnati Nyaas, Velhe. This provides guidance and education to the students in these rural areas straight from the professors of BMCC. Many Certificate Courses are made available for these students.



Rural-Urban Confluence

The Trust has always attempted to create a dialogue between the needy villagers and the urban people. Such programs help escalate the development through integral humanism.

One Day Picnic

The Trust arranges a Pune-Velha-Pune day tour on No Profit Basis to exhibit its array of work in the region. Buses with capacity of around 14-20-32-50 are arranged at reasonable charges.

Arogya Rakshak Yojana

No medical assistance is available to the villages in around Velha. In order to provide First Aid to these villages, an educated young person is trained to give First Aid. The concerned person is provided with a



First Aid Kit and a few medicines by the Trust. This has enabled medical assistance in the wee hours.

Veterinary Health Camp

In order to protect the animal husbandry of the villages, camps are conducted on timely basis of Government Veterinary Doctors or even the Private Veterinary Doctors.

Madheghat Visit (Optional) – Tea – Back to Pune at 7.00 p.m. Such is the itinerary of the day tour. A Volunteer of the Trust accompanies the group throughout the day.

Community Welfare through Agro Tourism

The Farmers always face the problem of lack of labour and its increasing demand. The Trust selects deserving farmers and arranges rice plantation activities for the Urban tourists. The tourists enjoy activity and feel refreshed with the mud therapy as well as are satisfied of being an active help to a needy farmer.




A big step of the Trust to approach its aim of social development – a Multi-Utility Building



With this aim, the Trust has undertaken construction of a new building encompassing all these facilities. The opening ceremony of the building was done at the hands of Shri. Bhaiyyaji Joshi, Sarkaryavah, RSS.
