School Van for Girl Students



For several years, our Trust has been dedicated to promoting girl education in the rural landscapes of Velha and Bhor. Recognizing the challenges faced by girl students in travelling long distances to school, we devised a solution to bridge this gap. The Trust initiated a commendable step by providing a free school bus service exclusively for these girls, starting with a minibus.

Acknowledging the impact of this initiative, the community and corporate social responsibility (CSR) played a pivotal role. Through CSR support, two substantial buses were generously donated to the Trust. Today, one bus is dedicated to school-going girls, while the other serves college-bound girls. This significant addition has transformed dreams into reality for many girls, empowering them to pursue further education with ease.

Construction of a Well in various villages



Addressing the pressing need for rural development in an area plagued by water scarcity despite abundant rainfall, the Trust actively engages in organizing Village Meets and Sarpanch Meets. These forums serve as platforms to discuss the challenges faced by villagers and explore viable solutions.

The Trust's dedicated efforts have resulted in the implementation of various initiatives, such as the construction of wells, weirs, deepening farm ponds, and leveling hills to facilitate farming on challenging terrains. Through meticulous surveys, the Trust identifies and prioritizes villages in dire need of support. Significant projects, including Ghisar, Gruhini, Khulshi, Nigde, Kumble, Waghmachi, Metpilavare, Chandavane, Damguda Asni, Wadgaon Zanze, Bhordi, Pabe, Karnvadi and Andgaon have witnessed successful well construction, effectively mitigating water scarcity in these regions.

Nyas has completed well constructions in 14 villages, but numerous others urgently require wells to address water scarcity. We appeal for your financial support to help build wells and put an end to water scarcity in these underserved areas.

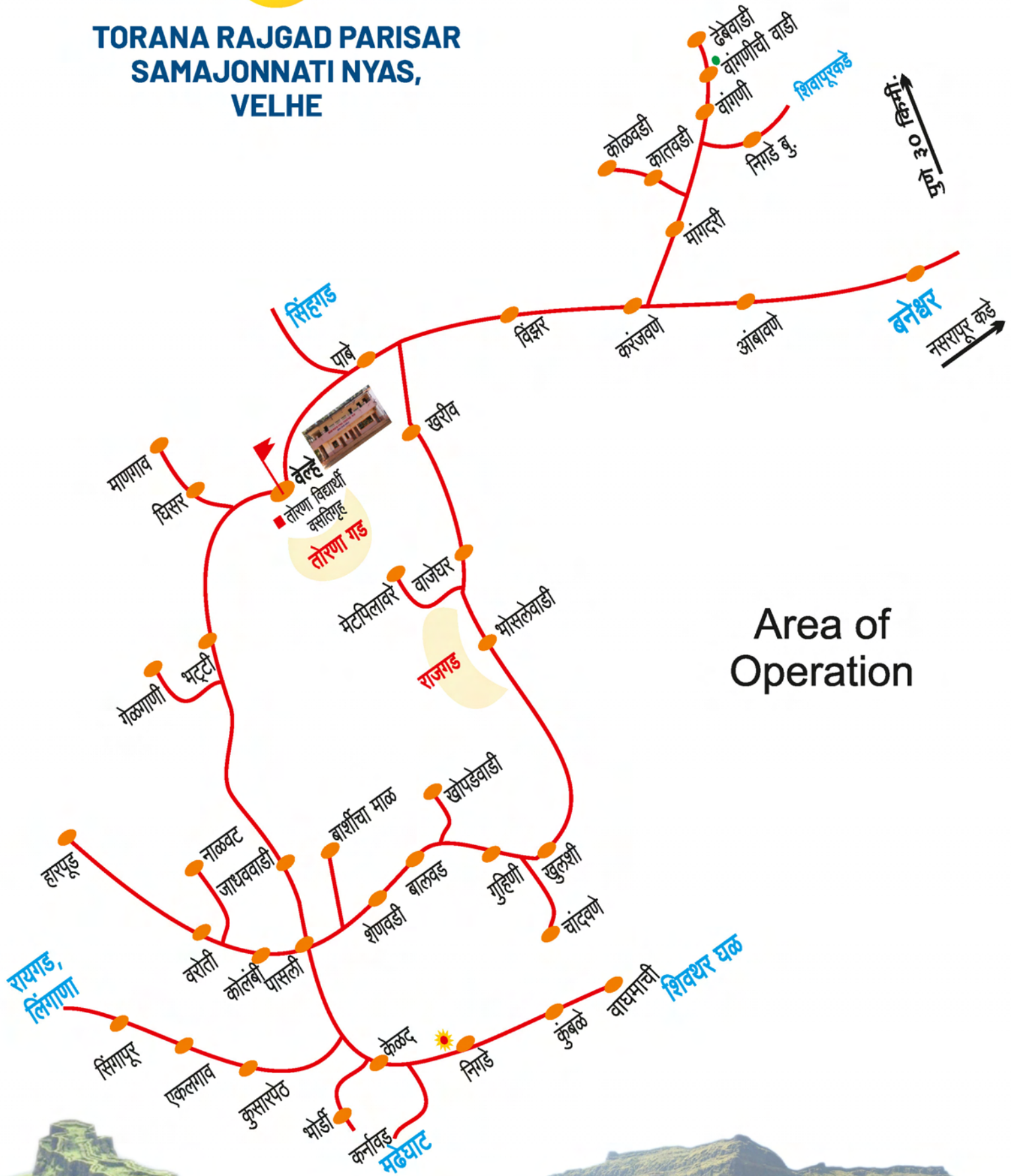

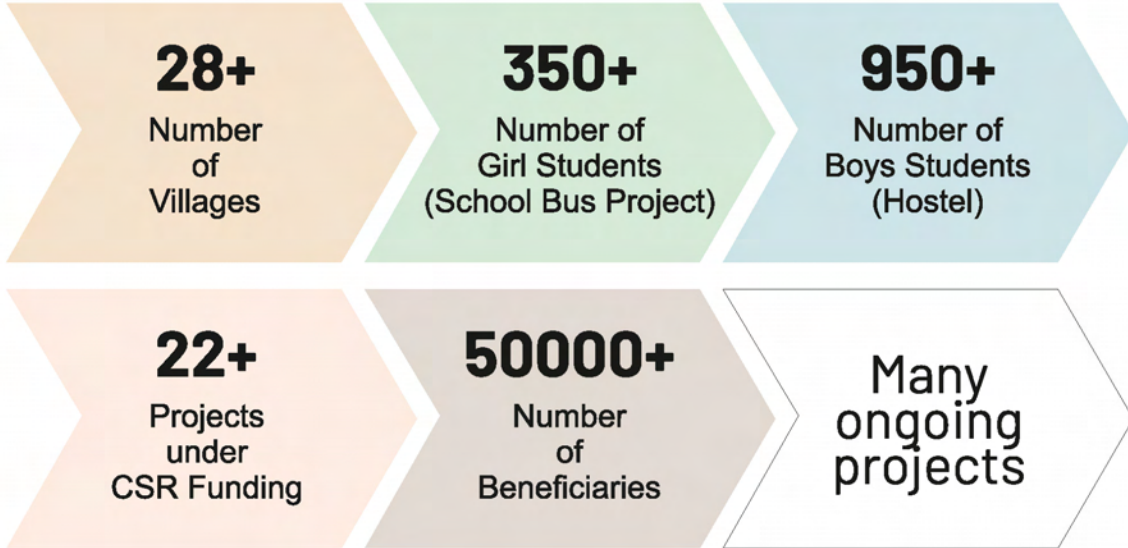
